Ms. Eckels, our art teacher, runs a weekly art club as well as a Family Art Night in the second trimester. Students in grades 9-12 can participate.

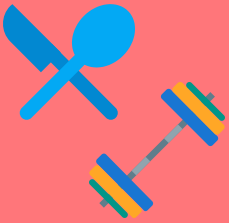

Students have the opportunity to cook with local police officers along with our in-house chefs or lift with cops in our fitness center to promote open communication and community.

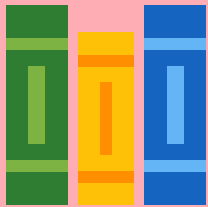

Do you want to workout with friends in a fun and welcoming environment? Well fitness club is the place for you! When school reopens, come join us after school on Tuesdays and Thursdays!

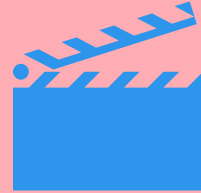

Students decide on the projects and we go out and make things happen. We have attended climate change summits with the city, registered people to vote, and helped with local food drives.

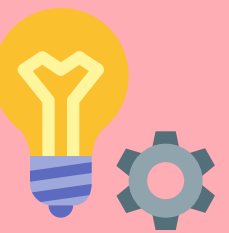

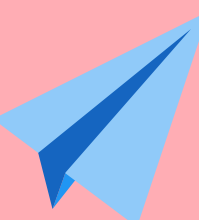
